Maths

Adding and subtracting and how to approach word problems with one and two steps.

Writing


English

This term Year 4 will be focusing on the book 'History Hackers' a Roman Rescue, planning, writing and self-evaluating our own narrative writing. We will continue to look at various aspects of SPAG during our English sessions with a particular focus on paragraphs, complex sentences and expression of speech

Reading:

During our reading sessions we will be focusing on various authors and selecting extracts from their books for our 'Text Interrogation' - with an emphasis on paragraphs.

Spelling continues to be a big focus in Year 4. We will continue to have weekly spelling tests and encourage the children to use taught spellings in their writing. Please continue to support with this at home. Reading and library books will continue to be reviewed and changed once a week. Please remind your child to bring their book in when they are ready to change it.



Theme

This half term we will be looking at Science with a particular focus on sound. How sound is made, volume pitch and volume.

History- The Romans- We will be exploring the enquiry question what was the impact the Romans had on Britain. Focusing on the building of Hadrian's Wall and how it affected life before and after.

Homework

Spellings

Spellings will be given out each Friday. To practise spellings your child can write out the word, cover and practise writing down the correct spelling. In class your child will look at the spelling pattern and spelling rule. It may help to underline the rule or pattern in each word when practising. Spelling practise can be short bursts throughout the week and can be completed in a written form or orally.

To fully understand the meaning of the word, please encourage your child to look up the meaning of the spelling words each week.

Maths Homework will be posted on Teams each week. It will be named homework under the corresponding week. Maths work will linked to content covered in class. Completed Maths homework should be posted under the homework task on class dojo
