As always, your children will be working on times tables on a weekly basis. Help with these at home is greatly appreciated.



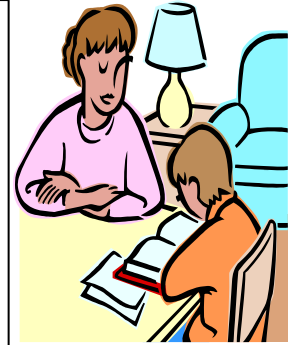
## English

The book we will be focusing on this half-term is *Goodnight Mr Tom* by Michelle Magorian. During this half term we will be focusing on different aspects of SPaG as well as editing and peer assessment, proofreading for errors, and correcting spelling mistakes. We will also be producing diary entries linked to our History work.



### Homework

Homework will be sent home on Fridays via Microsoft Teams. Homework will continue to focus on English and Maths and will need to be returned on Classdojo the following week. Spellings will also be set each week and the children will continue to be tested throughout this half term.



### Theme

We will be focusing on WW2 this half term, where we will be enriching our History skills by learning about Anne Frank, looking at rationing within Maths and creating our own historical narrative.

This theme will lead us in to a range of text types for our writing, including diary entries and non-chronological reports.

In Art we will be focusing on the sculptures created by Cornelia Parker to help us create our own.
