Agreement for Parents/Carers

We will.....

Ensure that our child attends school regularly and inform the school of the reason for each day's absence.

Work with the school to ensure that our child behaves well.

Attend termly consulatationmeetings and discussions about our child's progress at school.

Keep discussions about school positive.

Talk to the school if our child is worried about attending school or if something happens to affect our child's learning and wellbeing (including medical information).

Regularly read any information provided by the school, including newsletters and emails, so that I keep up to date with important details of relevant information and upcoming events.

Provide information about the work planned for each child.

Keep parents/carers informed about a child's next steps and progress.

Organise regular homework activities and give guidance on other learning opportunities.

Look after each child's safety and wellbeing.

Provide 'bucket list' opportunities for children to grow socially and emotionally.

Support your child to develop a spiritual, moral and ethical compass for life, enabling them to grow up to be the best person they can be.

Welcome you into the life of the school and work in partnership with parents, carers and children upholding the school vision & values.

Offer a broad, balanced and ambitious curriculum that meets the need of each child.

Contact parent/carer if we are concerned about a child's work or behaviour.

Promote the school's Christian ethos and respect the religious beliefs of others.

Teach your child to develop a positive attitude to others, regardless age, disability, gender reassignment, race, religion or belief, sex, marriage or civil partnership, pregnancy and maternity.
