## Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to celebrate the children's hard work this year by taking them to Bristol Aquarium, details are as follows.

## When: Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July

Time: Leaving school at 8:30 am and returning by 3:10 pm Cost: £24.60 to be paid in two instalments, £12.30 by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May and the remaining £12.30 by Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2024. Please pay asap via ParentPay and tick the consent box, to give your permission for your child to attend.

As this is not an educational trip, unfortunately, we can only accommodate pupils that have paid in full and by the deadline. Children that do not attend will spend the day in school, with other year groups. If payment is an issue, please contact us as soon as possible.

**Uniform/Clothing:** School uniform to be worn. Depending on the weather, they will need a sunhat and sun cream/raincoat. Sensible/ comfortable footwear should be worn.

Lunch Arrangements: When you pay via ParentPay, please indicate whether you would like a cheese or ham school packed lunch, or whether you will provide a packed lunch from home. Please also provide snacks to last throughout the day and two drinks (preferably water, not fizzy or milk based). They will be required to carry all their things with them all day, so please provide a small backpack.

**Travel Sickness:** If your child suffers from travel sickness, please give them medication before they leave. If they need medication for the return journey, please hand the medication to a member of staff, in a named, sealed envelope with written instructions.
