Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 1 to 4 Carol Concert on 19th December 2024

We are pleased to work together with our partner school, Grange Juniors, to present a Carol Concert on Thursday 19th December 2024. Year 1, 2, 3 and 4 will be taking part in this event.

Please find all the details you need for the Carol Concert below:

Location: Grange Infants' School - Year 2 playground

Please enter the site via Delamere Drive, through the gates that connect the carpark and the playground.

Times: The playground gates will open at 1:35pm. Please stay within the designated area in the playground to ensure that our children have access to their performance positions and the school building. There will be members of staff on site if you require assistance. We are expecting the concert to finish at 2:45pm.

Collecting children after the concert: At the end of the concert, Grange Infants' pupils will return to their classrooms with their teachers to collect their belongings. Then the Juniors children who are being collected directly from the Infants' school, will enter the building via the hall doors to collect their belongings.

Year 1: once the children have their belongings, they will be released to parents Through the usual Year 1 exits.

Year 2: once the Juniors children, who are being collected directly from the Infants School, have been released to their parents via the Infants' school hall doors, the Year 2 children will be released to parents through the school hall doors where you normally collect them from.

Year 3 and 4: A letter will go out to all Year 3 and 4 parents and carers to offer you the option of collecting your child directly from the Infants' school after the concert. If you wish to collect your child from the Infants' school, you will need to complete the online form **by Friday 13th December**. Children who are not on the list to be collected directly from the Infants' school, will return to Grange Junior School with their teachers, straight after the concert. These children will

If the weather does, unfortunately, turn out to be inclement to such an extent that it will affect your and the children's enjoyment of the concert, we will contact you via email on the day to update you on any changes of the arrangements.

Parking: Please remember to be considerate of the school's neighbours when parking. Please think, if it blocks anyone's drive or isn't safe, don't park there. Only those families with a parking permit can access the school site to limit the amount of traffic accessing the car park.

Additional information: There will be limited seating available for disabled and elderly visitors, as well as others who may need it. Please feel free to contact our school office ahead of the concert if you want us to reserve a seat.
