We are working with staff currently to finalise our new school vision to support the values that have already been decided upon. This also means that the class names will be changing in September and the children will be part of this process before the end of term.

Your child is invited to spend Wednesday 2nd July and Thursday 3rd July at the Junior School. On these days, please bring your child to the Community Centre Gate for drop off at 9am. They will remain at school with us for the whole day and will be collected from the playground at 3:30pm. The children will be moving up in their current classes and staff will be on hand to welcome them to their new classrooms. The children will spend the day in their new classrooms which are directly opposite the Community Gate entrance. We will meet and greet the children on the playground and get them lined up as a class before we enter the school. Parents are welcome to wait with their children. Please be aware that this gate will be used by the other children beforehand and so this space can be quite busy.

On Wednesday 2nd July we will hold a meet and greet session in the school hall at 9am after drop off. This meeting is likely to last no longer than 20 minutes but gives us an opportunity to share some important information with you and provide you with a welcome pack.

New to Year 1,2,4,5 and 6

Children will all go to the current classrooms as normal. They will then be sent to their new classes once they have been registered. At the end of each day most children will return to their current classes and be collected as usual.

Important: If your child is currently in Mr Foord's or Mrs Hodge's class please collect from the hall

Children will spend both of these days in their new classrooms with their new teacher. They will spend today getting to know each other and completing a range of activities.
