## Music at the May Fayre

## **EYFS and Year 1**

## Year 2, 3 and 4

Parents/carers to meet Mrs Barton next to the stage on the Grange Juniors playground at **11:50**. The children will then sing 3 songs from **12:00** to approximately **12:10**. After the singing, teachers will release the children back to their parents.

## Year 5 and 6

Parents/carers to meet Mrs Barton next to the stage on the Grange Juniors playground at **12:20**. The children will then sing 3 songs from **12:30** to approximately **12:40**. After the singing, teachers will release the children back to their parents.

Parents/carers will at all times be responsible for their children's belongings. It's not compulsory for the children to take part in the singing, however, **if you would like your child to take part, you will need to sign up for this. Details on how to do this will follow shortly.**
