### **Uniform Change – Parent FAQ**

Thank you for the positive feedback we have received regarding the proposed uniform change. We are pleased to share that we will be moving to a green uniform across both schools and this will begin to be phased in from September. ### **When will the new uniform start?**

The new green uniform will begin from September, but all current uniform can continue to be worn throughout the next academic year. This gives families time to use existing items and replace them gradually.

### **What is changing?**

- Green jumpers and cardigans will replace burgundy.
- Logos are optional – plain green items are acceptable.
- From Year 1 upwards, children will move to school trousers, skirts or pinafores rather than the full active uniform.
- Black trainers can be worn from EYFS to Year 6

### **What about EYFS?**

The active uniform will remain the same for Reception children.

### **What about PE kit and house colours?**

- Logoed PE T-shirts will be available.
- Plain house-colour T-shirts are also fine, offering a low-cost option.

### **Will book bags and PE bags change?**

- Current burgundy book bags and drawstring bags can continue indefinitely.
- Green versions of book bags will also be available for those who prefer them.

**What support is available for families?**

We will always endeavour to support families as much as possible. If you need support in providing your child with school uniform please do get in contact.

**What will happen to old burgundy uniform?**

FOGS are looking into responsible recycling and donation options to reduce waste and make good use of items no longer needed.

**Will children look mismatched during the transition?**

There will be a mix of burgundy and green next year, but this is intentional to avoid unnecessary cost. All children will be supported to feel comfortable and included.
