Dear Parents,

We are writing to you with information regarding our transition activities next week.

**New to Year 3**

Your child is invited to spend Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July and Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July at the Junior School. On these days, please bring your child to the Community Centre Gate for drop off at 08:45am. They will remain at school with us for the whole day and will be collected from the playground at 3:30pm. The children will be moving up in their current classes and staff will be on hand to welcome them to their new classrooms. The children will spend the day in their new classrooms which are directly opposite the Community Gate entrance. We will meet and greet the children on the playground and get them lined up as a class before we enter the school. Parents are welcome to wait with their children. Please be aware that this gate will be used by the other children beforehand and so this space can be quite busy.

If you have ordered a hot school dinner for your child this will automatically be served at the Juniors. If you have not ordered a hot dinner, please provide your child with a packed lunch. At morning break, you may wish to provide your child with a healthy snack e.g. fruit or vegetables. We will also have KS1 fruit on offer, and milk, where it has been pre-ordered.

On Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July, we will hold a meet and greet in the school hall at 9:00am after drop off. This will last no longer than 20 minutes but will be an opportunity to ask any questions to Mrs Gordon, Miss Pound and the members of the pastoral team. We will also have some examples of Year 3 work on show to give you an idea of how your child's learning will progress into Key Stage 2.

**New to Years 1, 2, 4, 5 and 6**

On Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July and Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July, children will all go to the current classrooms as normal. They will then be sent to their new classes once they have been registered. At the end of each day most children will return to their current classes and be collected as usual.

**Important: If your child is currently in Mrs Barton's or Mrs Hodge's class, please collect from the main school hall via the Birchwood Side of the building.**

Children will spend both of these days in their new classrooms with their new teacher. They will spend the day getting to know each other and completing a range of activities.

If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact either school.
