Year Two trip to Paulton's Park - Reminder

We are all very much looking forward to our end of year trip to Paulton's Park on Tuesday 4 July.

Please can all children be in school at 7.45 am, so that we can register them and promptly leave at 8am. We are aiming to arrive back at approximately 5pm, if this changes we will let you know asap.

Suncream - Please make sure that your child has sun cream applied before coming to school. They may then bring this with them to reapply, as long as they can do this themselves.

Clothing - Sensible shoes will be extremely important for the trip, trainers are ideal as we will be doing lots of walking. School uniform to be worn and every child **MUST** have a hat.

Food & Drink - All children need to carry their own lunch and any snacks they will need, preferably in a small backpack. If you have requested a school packed lunch, these can be added to their bags. They will need plenty to drink (nothing fizzy or milk based) at least 2 bottles. We would prefer it if they could bring refillable water bottles so that we can take advantage of the refillable water stations should we need to.

Travel Sickness - If your child gets travel sick, please ensure they have their travel sickness tablet before coming to school. Tablets for the return journey should be handed to the class teacher, in a named envelope with instructions for administering.
