We are pleased to inform you that Year 2 will be visiting the Museum & Art Swindon on Tuesday 14th July.

During the visit, the children will take part in a guided tour of the museum, exploring its object-rich galleries and discovering a range of fascinating artefacts. They will also participate in a hands-on, curriculum-focused workshop led by the museum's specialist Learning Team. During the session, the children will investigate rocks, fossils, soils, and Swindon's hidden underground treasures. This engaging workshop will support their scientific learning through practical exploration and discovery. Details are as follows.

When: Tuesday 14th July

Time: Leaving school at 8:45 and returning by 3:15pm. Children will be attending in two groups, one group at 9:30am -11:30am and one at 1-3pm.

The cost of the trip will be **£6.14**. Please note that this contribution is voluntary, and your support is sincerely appreciated. However, we hope you can acknowledge that we can only proceed with these trips if the associated costs are met. In the event that insufficient contributions are received and the trip is unable to go ahead, parents and carers will be notified prior to the scheduled date, and full refunds will be issued to all who have contributed.

Uniform/Clothing: School uniform to be worn. Sensible/comfortable footwear should be worn.

Lunch Arrangements: The children will attend the museum in two groups, with one group visiting in the morning and the other in the afternoon. As a result, lunch arrangements at school will remain unchanged. Children will either have lunch before leaving for the museum or upon their return. Please also provide a drink (preferably water, not fizzy or milk based), children will be required to carry all their things with them all, so please provide a small backpack.

We are looking forward to sharing this exciting learning experience with the children know they will enjoy the opportunity to explore the museum and take part in the workshop activities.
