

School Keep Clear NO STOPPING, NO EXCUSES

No stopping or parking on entrance markings

If you stop, you will be liable for a Penalty Charge Notice of £70



What are School Keep Clears for?

For safety - to restrict parking so that pedestrians, especially school children wishing to cross, have a clear view. They also help drivers, who are often unable to see small children waiting to cross between parked cars.

No parking, waiting, loading/unloading, dropping off or picking up passengers is permitted on a School Keep Clear marking during its controlled hours. Blue Badge Holders are NOT exempt from this restriction.

What are the alternatives to driving to school?

Try 'Park and Stride - park away from the school entrance and walk the last 5-10 minutes. (Your school may already have a '5 minute walk zone' marked out.) This disperses the cars and reduces the number in any one place to a safer level. Walking half a mile only takes between 8 and 15 minutes. How many calories you burn depends on how fast you walk!

Try a walking bus - organise a small group of parents to share the walk to school and take it in turns to do the school run. You could even combine this idea with Park and Stride

Try car-sharing - if you have to drive to school then get together with other parents who need to go by car and take it in turns to drive.
