## Asthma Register

We are in the process of updating our school Asthma Register. If your child suffers with this debilitating condition, it is very important that the school is informed and that the medical details we hold are correct and up-to-date. It is very important that children have their inhalers in school every day and we would ask for your help in ensuring this is the case.

Asthma varies in severity from person to person and for individuals from month to month at different times in their lives. Symptoms include: coughing (particularly a night time cough); shortness of breath; wheezing; tightness in the chest, sometimes younger children will express this tightness as a tummy ache. Some children may experience a number of these symptoms, whilst others may experience only one.

In order to update our records and to ensure all staff are fully aware of the needs of individual children, I would be most grateful if you would complete and return the attached slip by **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> October 2023**, if we do not receive a response by this date, we will assume you do not wish your child to be placed on the asthma register. The information given will be held in strict confidence. Please ensure that all medication and equipment brought or held in school is in date and has your child's name on it.
