Important SATs Information

Dear Parents / Carers,

The children are continuing to work hard in preparation for their SATs which will begin the week commencing **Monday 11th May 2026**. We are extremely proud of the children and all of the effort they have put in this year. It is an exciting time; an opportunity for them to demonstrate their skills, and we feel confident they will do exceedingly well.

In school, adults have worked together to ensure that the week is well organised to support all of the children as best we can. The tests will be spread out throughout the week (Monday to Thursday); a timetable is included below for your attention.

Throughout the academic year, children have had mock SATs at the end of each term, so they are familiar with the routine and procedure we have to follow.

During SATs week

- **Breakfast (OPTIONAL):** We will provide the children with breakfast (if they would like it) and invite them into school from **8:15am**. As the main school gates will not be open at this time, can you please direct your child in through the main school office.
- **Attendance:** Attendance is vital, and it is important for your child to arrive to school no later than 8:30am. If your child is unable to attend school, please inform the school office ASAP by calling 01793 822405.
- **Water:** To help the tests run smoothly, please can you ensure your child brings a water bottle to school each day. Children will be given the opportunity to fill this at school if needed.
- **Sleep:** Lastly, can we please ask that your child has a good amount of sleep the night before their SATs as getting enough sleep helps to reduce stress and improve mood and concentration.

This Year's KS2 assessments take place over four days from 11th to 14th May 2026. The timetable is:

- Monday 11th May – English grammar, punctuation and spelling
- Tuesday 12th May – English reading
- Wednesday 13th May – Mathematics (arithmetic and reasoning)
- Thursday 14th May – Mathematics (reasoning)
