## **Stone Farm Kit List 2023**

The emphasis must be on practical rather than fashionable clothing. All of the items below should be packed in a sports bag or preferably a small suitcase. The bag and all items inside should be labelled with your child's name.

Teddy  
Sleeping bag or covered duvet in a labelled bin bag  
Single sheet  
Pillowcase (a non - allergy pillow is provided) / Own pillow (optional)  
Spare, labelled bin bag for return journey  
Pyjamas / dressing gown  
Waterproof (Kagool type)  
Towel (large enough for showers)  
Small towel for washing  
Toilet bag with toiletries (roll on deodorant only please, NO AEROSOLS)  
Sufficient underwear and socks  
Slippers (worn in the farmhouse)  
Wellingtons (essential as worn everyday) and some long socks.  
Shoes / trainers (worn on day visits)/ Walking boots / waterproof footwear for Dartmoor Day  
Tracksuit bottoms (jeans are not good for Dartmoor).  
Old clothes for farm jobs – jeans etc.  
Shorts / skirts / leggings (seasonal).  
T – Shirts  
A warm jumper / sweatshirt  
A swimming costume and towel in their own plastic bag.  
4 plastic carrier bags – for dirty washing  
Reading book  
Pack of tissues  
Sun hat, sun cream and lipsil  
Named disposable cameras are welcome.  
Water bottle  
Watch (optional but advisable)

All children will need a rucksack/backpack which is large enough to hold an A4 clipboard. Lunch and water bottle for the journey down should be stored in this rucksack & taken on the coach. No other food should be supplied including sweets.

Please make sure that children do not bring any electrical equipment including digital cameras or mobile telephones.

All medicines / inhalers should be labelled with name, dosage and frequency and handed by an adult to the school office preferably by Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July.

Children who use an inhaler, however infrequently, should carry one at all times and hand in their spare to the teacher collecting medicines on the day of departure.
