Dear Parents,

I am writing to inform you of the strike action proposed by the National Education Union (NEU) on Thursday 27 April. We are anticipating these arrangements to be the same for the strike on Tuesday 2 May, and if anything changes we will notify you. This is a national dispute that will affect some staff within our school who are members of this union.

To ensure the safety and wellbeing of our pupils, we have undertaken a risk assessment for the school and feel on these occasions we are only able to open for Year 6 children and children who are invited into school on the day of the strikes

Food will be available for all students attending on these days. If your child normally receives a FSM and you would like them come to school for their lunch at 12:30 please inform the office.

Please note that we are unaware of the specific numbers of teaching and support staff who may be joining picket lines on strike days, but minimising disruption to our pupils who attend the school on those days remains our priority.

We apologise for the inconvenience this will cause, but we hope that a clear decision will enable you to make plans ahead of the disruption expected.

If there are any developments at a national level, and if strike action is averted in schools, this will be notified through our usual school communication channels.

I want to thank you for your continued engagement with myself and the senior team during this national strike action. If you have any concerns or questions, please do not hesitate to contact the school office.
