Year 3

This week in year 3, we have been practicing using our subordinating conjunctions as, while, before and after. We have also produced a character description of the big bad pig making sure we described his appearance and his personality.

In science we carried out a reflection investigation where we shone a torch onto different surfaces to see if the light reflected. We found out that shiny metals are good for reflecting but black card is not as it absorbs the light.

On Thursday we had great fun taking part in a jumping circuit for our leap year activity. We then got to design our own themed jumping circuit.

Year 4

This week in year 4, we have been looking at 3 digits by 1 digit multiplication in maths. We were able to solve some very complicated problems that involved multiple regroupings. In writing, we have been looking at similes using 'like' and 'as' and hyperbole which obviously, we were the best in the world at. In French this week, we continued to look at different types of fruits – this time looking at masculine fruits.

On Thursday, we took part in an amazing leap year day themed circuit. We practised 7 different types of jumps and really challenged ourselves.

Year 6

This week, Year 6 have worked incredibly hard in maths. We have been looking at methods to find a percentage of a number and applied our knowledge of scale factors to scale drawings. In English, we have continued our diary writing journey with the book, 'How to live forever' by Colin Thompson. The first batch of diaries from Peter's perspective were fantastic and we are looking forward to seeing what they come up from the Ancient Boy's point of view. On Thursday, we celebrated leap year. We enjoyed our day and tried a variety of activities like: Leapfrog tag and circuit creation. In the latter we were tasked with creating out own inclusive circuit to promote the leap year. Year 5

This week in Year 5, we have been continuing our work on fractions, decimals and percentages. We have been looking at the equivalent fractions and decimals of tenths and hundredths. In English we are writing diary entries based upon our book, Boy 87. We have studied different types of adverbials including adverbial phrases and clauses. Also, this week, we have looked at the different forms of past tenses. On Thursday, we celebrated leap day by playing Roll a Jump and designing a 6-station circuit with each station having a leaping theme.
