

# **Grange Junior School** Round Up Term 4 – Issue 3 – 2024 Termly Value – Resilience

#### Year 3

This week we have wrote an alternative ending to the story 'The Three Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig' using subordinating conjunctions, direct speech and characterisation skills. In reading we have explored instructions and their different features including imperative verbs. We have started division in maths and learnt that division is the inverse to multiplication. To celebrate World Book Day the author Kita Mitchell visited and we were able to take part in a workshop, as well as, having the opportunity to ask her questions about what it is like being an author. In DT we investigated different nets used to make 3D shapes. We then created a 3D shape using Polydron or paper nets ready for when we design our own clamshell structure.

#### Year 4

This week, year 4 have started in maths a new unit of division, they all showed real resilience. We have also finished our Big write linked to our book Barnabus Project.

As we celebrated book week the children enjoyed making tops hats celebrating their favorite book characters. Some wonderful creations were made. They also had an amazing time attending the workshop run by our visiting author Kita Mitchell. To top the week off all the children enjoyed their hot chocolate treat on Friday.

#### Year 6

This week, Year 6 have been looking at a variety of methods in Maths to tackle measurement, area and perimeter tasks. In English, we have been looking at the necessary skills for witing a persuasive text. They have been specifically looking at Rhetorical questions with the theme of living forever. At the start of the week, we had a very exciting Science lesson where we created our own fossils using salt dough. Year 6 thoroughly enjoyed this lesson and are excited to learn more about evolution and inheritance. Finally, thank you to all the children across the school who will be doing their bit next week to help the Year 6's as they get Secondary Ready. Everybody's team effort and hard work is really paying off. Keep it up!

#### Year 5

This week, year 5 have been completing their Phase 3 write, which was a retell of our main character's escape from a prison camp. It has been great to see the range of skills the children have used in their writing, successfully engaging the reader.

In Science, we have enjoyed exploring friction through testing the friction caused by an object when it is pulled across different surfaces. Many of our predictions were accurate and allowed us to evaluate our experiment.

World Book Day has been highly successful with our workshop with Kita Mitchell producing excellent narratives based on given facts. We are really proud of the effort year 5 have put into the workshops, well done.
