• **Spelling, punctuation and grammar** activities will be completed regularly each week and incorporated into our writing

• **Writing and reading:** The children will be studying *The Hounds of the Baskervilles* by Sir Arthur Conan Doyle. They will learn about cliff hangers and formal reports and will write their own.

• **Reading:** The children will read daily. This may be independently, with a partner or to an adult. They will also complete a guided reading session each week where emphasis will be placed on their comprehension skills.
