- **Reading:** The children will read daily through teacher led comprehension activities.

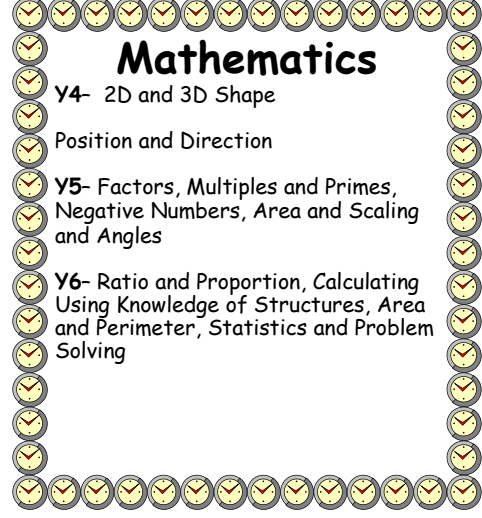

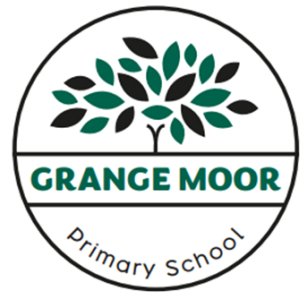
