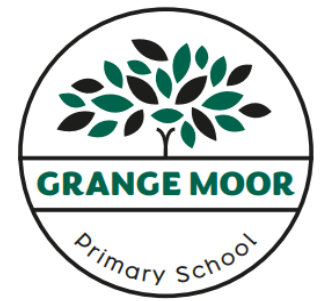


Grange Moor Primary School

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that Class 1 and Class 2 will be going on an exciting educational school trip to **Lotherton Hall** on **Monday 13th July 2026**.

This trip has been carefully planned to support the children's learning while also providing them with a fun and memorable experience outside the classroom. During the visit, Class 1 will take part in an *All About Penguins!* workshop, while Class 2 will participate in a *Classification* workshop. Both sessions link closely to what the children have been learning in school this year.

The cost of the trip will be £15 per child. We are pleased to share that this has been made possible at such a reduced cost thanks to the kind donation from our PTA, Friends of Grange Moor (FoG). Sign-up and consent for this trip will be via Arbor only. Please ensure that consent is given and payment is completed by **6th July 2026** to secure your child's place.

Children should be dropped off and collected at their normal school times on the day of the trip. All children must attend in full school uniform and bring a named water bottle. If warm weather is forecast, please ensure your child brings an appropriate sun hat and that sun cream has been applied before school.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch on the day. If your child is entitled to free school meals and you would like a packed lunch provided by school, please let us know by **Friday 22nd May**, so we have enough time to order and prepare accordingly.

The children will travel by **coach** and will be accompanied by school staff at all times to ensure their safety and wellbeing.
