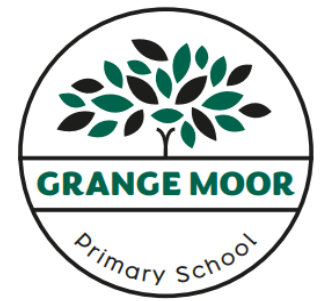

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you about an important part of our Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) curriculum. In line with our statutory responsibilities, we are required to teach children about changing and growing up, as well as aspects of relationships education and health education, throughout Years 1 to 6. These lessons are delivered in an age-appropriate way, with content and discussion carefully tailored to the needs and maturity of each year group.

The Department for Education (DfE) requires all primary schools to provide Relationships Education and Health Education at Key Stages 1 and 2. As a result, these lessons are a legal requirement. Our teaching is designed to support pupils in developing a secure understanding of themselves, their relationships with others, and the changes they may experience as they grow older.

We appreciate that some aspects of this curriculum may prompt questions or concerns.
