Good afternoon,

From Thursday 12th February until and inclusive of Thursday 16th July, Year 3, 4 & 5 will begin swimming lessons as part of the Kirklees Active Leisure (KAL) School Swimming Scheme. These lessons form part of the National Curriculum, which means all pupils are required to take part in swimming sessions. Children may only be exempt for medical reasons and in such cases a medical letter must be provided to the school.

The children will attend swimming every Thursday morning, travelling by coach from school and returning afterwards. Lessons will be delivered by qualified Kirklees Active Leisure swimming instructors, and pupils will be supervised by Mrs Maundrill and another member of staff or approved volunteer, in line with KAL and school supervision guidelines.

Please ensure your child brings the following each week, as required by Kirklees Active Leisure:

- Swimming costume or swimming trunks
(Bikinis, tankinis, or loose holiday shorts are not permitted)
- Towel
- Swimming cap
- Goggles (optional but recommended)
- All items in a suitable named bag

Please note that jewellery should not be worn during swimming lessons for safety reasons.

There will not be time for the children to shower after their lesson. In line with Kirklees Active Leisure school swimming procedures, pupils will towel dry and get dressed as quickly as possible, therefore shampoo or toiletries are not required.
