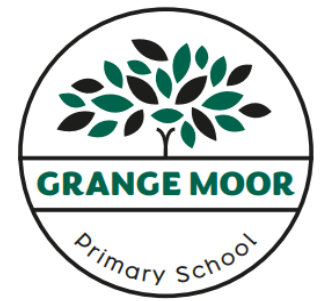

Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to share details of two upcoming transition opportunities for our Year 6 children as they prepare for their move to secondary school.

Tuesday 7th July – King James’ School Transition Day

On this day, children will visit their new school as part of their official transition. **Transport has been arranged by KJS**, so children should attend school as normal and will be taken to and from their new school during the day. You should have already received a letter from KJS with full details about the day, including arrangements for lunches and activities.

If your child is attending another school, their transition day arrangements will be similar; however, you will have received all the relevant information directly from that school, as we have not been provided with their specific details.

Thursday 9th July – Visit to The Zone

We are also pleased to offer Year 6 children the opportunity to visit *The Zone* on **Thursday 9th July**. They will take part in a range of fun activities in their new form groups at KJS.

Children who will not be attending KJS are still very welcome to attend, as it promises to be a fun and exciting day for everyone.

Please note the arrangements for this day:

- Children should be **dropped off at The Zone at 10:00am** and **collected at 2:00pm**
- **A member of staff will be present throughout**
- Children will need to bring a **packed lunch and a water bottle**
- Please ensure they wear **appropriate clothing and footwear for sports activities**

If you have any difficulties with transport, please let us know and we will do our best to support where we can.

The cost of the visit to The Zone is **£8.25 per child**, which is now available to book via **Arbor**.
