



Expectations

Every student attending Grange Futures and Academy is expected to follow simple rules and expectations. For further guidance please see the school website.



Attendance

- All pupils should be present for the start of the school day which is 9.00 am. Good attendance is a key part in preparing pupils for success after Grange and we know that our pupils will not make progress if they are not here.



A pupil being **late twice a week** over a school year is equivalent to missing **36 hours** of learning in that time.



Code of Conduct

- All pupils are expected to use appropriate language at all times. We will not tolerate discriminatory or offensive language.
- All pupils are expected to access all aspects of their learning. Where pupils have not done so they will be required to complete this work in their own time; this may be at lunch or after school.



Uniform

- All pupils are expected to wear uniform.
- All items of clothing should be appropriate for Grange School.
- Hoodies should not be worn up and hats or caps should not be worn in lessons.
- Balaclavas are not acceptable school uniform
- All pupils require appropriate PE kit and are expected to wear this in PE lessons.



Accessories

- Any bags and other accessories brought in by pupils will be left in classrooms or in the office. School will not be responsible for the loss of any items which are not passed to the office to be kept secure.



Technology

- Mobile phones or other any other devices must be left in the school office at all times. This is a safeguarding matter.
