From the cohort of pupils who have attended swimming this academic year, two year six pupils have achieved the national curriculum requirement that they can ‘competently, confidently and proficiently swim over a distance of at least 25 metres without any buoyancy aids.’

- These pupils can use a ‘range of strokes including forward stroke, backwards stroke and breaststroke which all can be performed effectively.’
- These pupils have been taught the ‘knowledge needed to perform a safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.’
- In the event of the pupils falling into water they could keep themselves afloat and shout for help, as well as being able to swim to the edge if they were able to get out.
