Our Ofsted report has been published and I thought I'd just share one or two key comments with you. There is so much to be proud of in it:


- The academy is a happy and welcoming community.

From Sept 2024, the government have announced funding for a national wraparound childcare programme. We are looking to find out your views on childcare for primary school aged children from reception to year 6.

The wraparound childcare can operate on a school site or at another setting in the area, term time only.
