Dear Parents/Carers.

September seems to have passed very quickly in school and, in the main, it has been a positive start to the school year. However, there are a couple of things that I must address with you all via this newsletter.

Firstly, school meals. I am aware that there have been some issues with our school meal offer. The catering is managed centrally by the Trust who partner with Aspens to deliver daily meals in all of the Cidari academies. I can assure you that all parties are working hard to make sure that the food offer is of the highest quality consistently. Although I do not have direct influence over this aspect of school life, getting this right is very important to me.

Secondly, there have been a number of requests to speak to class teachers - which is absolutely fine as two way dialogue is always best for everyone concerned. Giving the office staff an indication of what you wish to speak about makes the whole process much smoother. Your need may not be best addressed by the class teacher alone. The class teacher may require input from the special needs lead, literacy lead, behaviour lead or inclusion manager. This is no different from when you ring the doctors and they ask what your medical need is so that they can direct you to the correct part of the medical team. My office team understands confidentiality and will only speak to the necessary people.

On a similar note, all staff are in school for long hours BUT this time is allocated and meetings cannot be slotted in at a moment's notice. We will do our best to see you within 48 hours but this cannot be guaranteed.

Please remember that we have Mrs Stone on the yard every morning, with her clipboard, ready to deliver messages to any member of school staff and our gmsjoffice@cidari.co.uk email is another method of communication.

We care passionately about your children, their education and well-being. We will not always please all of the people all of the time, that is life and human nature, but we will try.

Our Food Bank 'Take what you need, give when you can' is now located in a lovely new shed at the front of school. Our fresh food delivery comes each Tuesday. I noticed a parent adding to the stock this week - he simply said he was able to give something back. Terrific and thank you. The door of the shed is shut simply because the wasps were loving the fresh fruit. It isn't locked, just open it up and help yourselves. School uniform is still in the entrance hall. One of our lovely mum's has washed and ironed it. There are some nearly new pieces on the rack - help yourself.
