

## **Revision Tips:**

You must read the question – **common mistakes** are when you are asked 'To use the figure and your own understanding; You must use both!

- **BUG the question** Box the command word, Underline the issue and glance for other key words.
- Answer the questions using **PEEL** Point, Evidence, Explain and Link.
- To answer graph questions use **TEA**: Trend, Example and Anomalies.
- Remember to focus on **key terms** in your revision- a question may have a specific key term in it. If you do not know the key term you will not be able to answer the question!
- Try and remember key Geographical case studies so you can use the examples in your answers.
- Find the revision style that works best for you! -mind maps/crunch notes.

- Use the **Scaffolding** support sheets on how to answer 12 and 20- mark questions.
