

Revision Tips <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● You must read the question – common mistakes are when you are asked ‘To use the figure and your own understanding; You must use both! ● BUG the question - Box the command word, Underline the issue and glance for other key words. ● Answer the questions using PEEL – Point, Evidence, Explain and Link. ● To answer graph questions – use TEA: Trend, Example and Anomalies. ● Remember to focus on key terms in your revision- a question may have a specific key term in it. If you do not know the key term you will not be able to answer the question! ● Try and remember key Geographical case studies so you can use the examples in your answers. ● Find the revision style that works best for you! -mind maps/crunch notes. ● Practice, practice and more practice!
