<p><b>Revision Tips</b> Practise tenses using languagesonline – self-marking and exercises can be repeated Kerboodle vocabulary builders – good for extending vocabulary and developing knowledge of synonyms and synonymous expressions (tier 2 vocabulary) AQA website – look at listening transcripts from past papers and translate sections of them into English Create mind maps for sub topics e.g. family – split into sections for nouns, adjectives, verbs associated with that topic Kerboodle – word-list – printed version available as well as audio list to check pronunciation</p>
