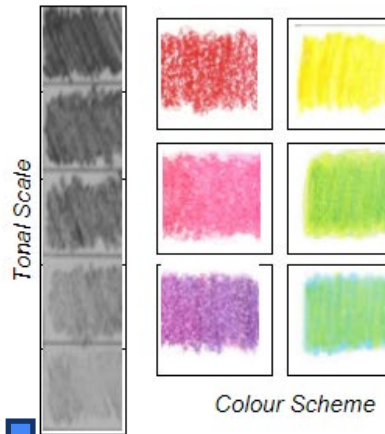
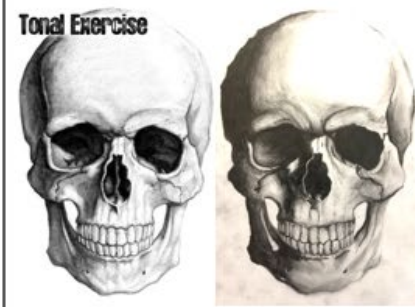

A common symbol of the holiday is the skull (in Spanish *calavera*). Day of the Dead altars and celebrations feature a wide range of flowers and bright colours.

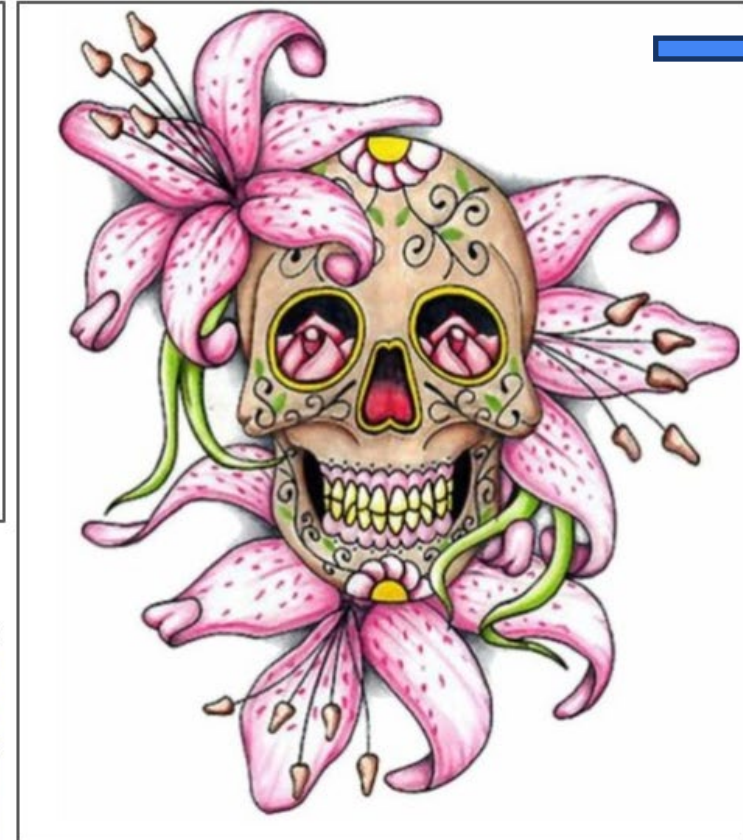
