

74% of employers are looking to employ people with language skills Customers addressed in their mother tongue are much more likely to do business with you

49% of employers are disappointed with graduates' foreign language skills A quarter of firms have lost business due to inadequate language skills amongst staff

How will studying languages help you?

- It will increase your job opportunities
- With the growth of the EU post-Brexit, there is a much greater need for people who have a foreign language
- The UK was the ONLY EU member state to have English as its first language
- 60% of all UK trade is with non Englishspeaking countries
- You can combine studying French at university with almost ANY other subject




Is French the right choice for you?


There are around 80 million native speakers of French

Official language in 29 countries


Unofficially spoken in 20 additional countries
