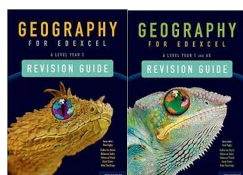

18th October	Tectonics Page 16-35 of Revision Guide 1
25th October	Coasts Page 60-80 of Revision Guide 1
1st November	Water Page 16-35 of Revision Guide 2
8th November	Globalisation Page 81-101 of Revision Guide 1
15th November	Regenerating Places Page 102-127 of Revision Guide 1
22nd November	Superpowers Page 57-76 of Revision Guide 2
29th November	Revise all/ summarise notes

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You must read the question – **common mistakes** are when you are asked ‘To use the figure and your own understanding; You must use both!

- **BUG the question** - Box the command word, Underline the issue and glance for other key words.
- Answer the questions using **PEEL** – Point, Evidence, Explain and Link.
- To answer graph questions – use **TEA**: Trend, Example and Anomalies.
- Remember to focus on **key terms** in your revision- a question may have a specific key term in it. If you do not know the key term you will not be able to answer the question!
- Try and remember **key Geographical case studies** so you can use the examples in your answers.
- **Find the revision style that works best for you!** -mind maps/crunch notes.
- **Practice, practice and more practice!** Exam Questions and mark schemes on AQA website
- Use the **Scaffolding** support sheets on how to answer 12 and 20- mark questions.
