Revision Tips

- Remember to focus on **key terms** in your revision- a question may have a specific key term in it. If you do not know the key term you will not be able to answer the question!
- Try and remember your key scholars. This is a clear criteria for the higher levels.
- Find the revision style that works best for you! Some people like mind-maps, some crunch notes, some cue cards! You need to find the method that works best for you to ensure your revision is effective.
- Read the examiner report- this will give you an insight into what the exam board are looking for!
- **Practice, practice and more practice!** Whether it is completing past exam questions or getting somebody at home to quiz you- practice makes perfect!
