A job in medicine relates to RS because...

 Doctors & Nurses need a firm understanding of medical ethics and many religious teachings have a direct influence on their job:

- Abortion
- Euthanasia
- Organ Transplants
- Blood Transfusions
- Genetic



A job in the police relates to RS because...

- Police Officers need to have a good understanding of multifaith and multi-cultural issues in order to do an effective job.
- They must show tolerance & understanding and be against prejudice & discrimination.
- Many UK laws are based on Christian laws & teachings!



A job as a lawyer relates to RS because...

- Lawyers & Judges must study Religion & Law as part of their training.
- Religion has influenced most of the laws in the UK, and also in other countries. They must have a good knowledge of religious beliefs & teachings as this may affect how a person lives and acts; they should also have a good knowledge of moral issues and ethics.
- It is vital that a lawyer is free from prejudice as they must treat everyone equally.





A job as a teacher relates to RS because...

- A teacher will usually encounter students and parents of all different races & religions and should be free from prejudice.
- Teachers should have a good understanding of religious beliefs & teachings as they should be able to encourage and empathise with students and their lives.



A job as a social worker relates to RS because...

- Social Workers must have a good understanding of religious and cultural issues in order to understand and empathise with the people they are entrusted to help.
- Religion and culture affect all aspects of life, from birth to death, in the home and at work. All social workers must be free from prejudice and must treat everyone with respect and equally!



A job in the army relates to RS because...

- The Armed Forces, especially the Army, should have a clear understanding of religious and cultural issues.
- When the Armed Forces are deployed overseas, to protect civilians in war-torn areas, they should have an understanding and empathy of their culture and differences.



Remember this...

- Choose your optional subjects because you think you'll be good at them, and that they will interest you
- Don't choose subjects because you want to be with a best friend or an inspirational teacher - your friendship may not last and the inspirational teacher may leave!
