49% of employers are disappointed with graduates foreign language skills.

 $\frac{1}{4}$ firms have lost business due to inadequate language skills amongst staff.



How will studying languages help you?

- It will increase your job opportunities
- With the growth of the European Union post BREXIT there is a much greater need for people who have a foreign language.
- The UK was the ONLY EU member state to have English as its first language - no EU country has English as its first language.
- 60% of all UK trade is with non Englishspeaking countries


