<p>Revision Tips Practise tenses using languagesonline – self-marking and exercises can be repeated Kerboodle vocabulary builders – good for extending vocabulary and developing knowledge of synonyms and synonymous expressions (tier 2 vocabulary) AQA website – look at listening transcripts from past papers and translate sections of them into English Create mind maps for sub topics e.g. family values– split into sections for nouns, adjectives, verbs associated with that topic Kerboodle – word-list – printed version available as well as audio list to check pronunciation</p>
