Dear Parent / Carer,

We are pleased to confirm the details of our Summer School Programme and would like to take this opportunity to invite your child to attend on **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> to Friday 27<sup>th</sup> August**. This programme will provide a great opportunity for your child to meet our staff, sample taster lessons and familiarise themselves with the layout of our school.

During the week the children will experience a variety of sessions with our staff and participate in a number of practical activities which will support their transition to high school. We ask that your child wears appropriate sports attire and therefore ask you **not to send them in their school uniform**. All equipment will be provided for the children on each day, we do however ask that you provide your child with a **drinks bottle and weather appropriate clothing** (hat, sun cream, waterproof coat etc.).

This will be the first opportunity your child will get to meet their form face to face and although the current restrictions will be lifted, we still hold the safety of our students and staff with the highest importance. Therefore, we will have different areas for arrival and departure.

## **Arrival and Departure times**

The school gates will be open at 9.20am, there will be **two separate entrances** and each form area will be clearly marked out on the yard. We ask that you make sure your child is dropped off at the correct location. They will then be taken to a room which will act as their form room for the week. The activities will start promptly at 9.30am, if you are running late then we ask that you drop your child off at the main reception where they will then be taken to their activity.

The day will end at **14.30pm** and the children will be **escorted back to their arrival site**. We ask that parents wait outside the gates as Great Sankey staff ensure students leave the premises safely.

We will be providing a free lunch that will consist of a sandwich, drink, piece of fruit and a bag of crisps. If you would prefer to provide a packed lunch for your child that is not a problem.
