Kind and Respectful

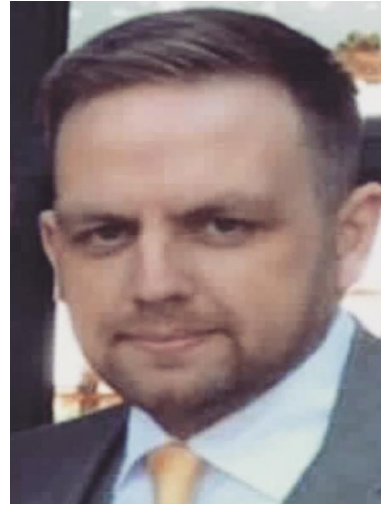
Students who wish to be successful always demonstrate kind and respectful behaviour to other students, staff and their learning environment.

Uniform Summary for September

COMPULSORY UNIFORM

- Tartan school skirt or black, formal style trousers (**no** jean-type material / style, leggings, lycra or similar) **No adjusting the length**
- Plain white school shirt with collar and top button (no logos)
- Clip on school tie - **RED for Year 7**
- Black blazer with school badge in white
- Plain, black ankle socks or plain black tights only (not patterned)
- Black flat shoes with no other colours or marking. They should be a polishable, smart, leather type shoe, not a suede, canvas or leather trainer / leisure footwear type.
- Green checked apron for Food Technology
- **No jewellery**
- **Mobile phones to be switch off in school**

OPTIONAL

- Black V-neck school jumper with school badge

COMPULSORY PE KIT:

- Rugby jersey with school badge (compulsory for boys only)
- Black polo shirt with school badge (compulsory for girls only)
- Black shorts or leggings/tracksuit bottoms with school badge only
- Black sports socks (plain or school name)

OPTIONAL

- Black sweat top with badge



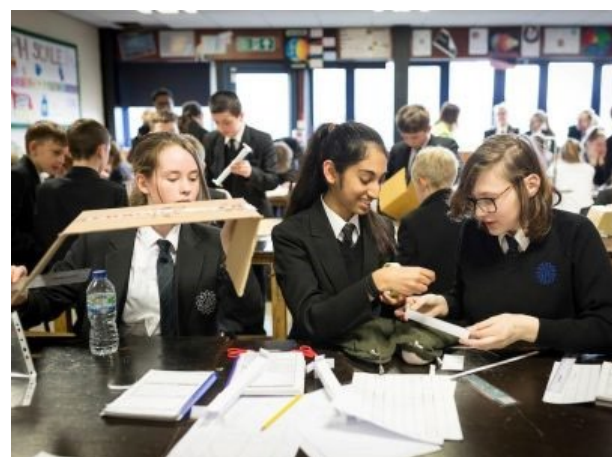
