Dear parent/carer,

As a student of GCSE History, I would like to invite you and your child to an after-school skills session which will allow you to support your child with their History studies. The purpose of the session is to give parents insight into what is expected of your child during their GCSE History exams.

The session will take place in the form of a “walking talking mock” where the History department will model how to approach a GCSE History exam. This will involve some discussion about different approaches but will also give you some idea of the exam skills your child can be practising at home and how you can support them in their preparation. All materials will be provided.

The session will be a one-hour workshop, in the sports hall with two time slots available. The first slot will be between 4.15– 5.15pm and the second will be between 5.30pm – 6.30pm. The session will take place on **11th November 2021**, giving students and parents enough time to put the strategies into practice before the mock exams in November. There are 80 spaces available for each session (1 space is one student and one parent).
