

Dear Parents/Carers

Year 11 have made a fabulous start to their final GCSE year; when I have visited lessons and assemblies it has been pleasing to see such enthusiasm and determination to succeed. It is clear to see that each student is striving to reach their full potential and as a staff we are fully committed to supporting them.

Each year, subject teachers provide intervention sessions in the form of after-school sessions which run from 2.50 pm – 3.50 pm. These session focus on revising key subject specific content and developing examination skills and technique. Although these sessions are not compulsory, **regular** attendance has been shown to have a positive impact on the outcomes of our students and we would encourage students in year 11 to take advantage of as many available sessions as possible.

Afterschool intervention begins in earnest this week and the table below outlines which sessions are available and when this term. We have tried to minimise clashes as far as possible but where these do occur, students will be able to select their own priority.
