What are we looking for? Use of a wide tonal range. Lights, mid-greys and darks. Bended tones. Good proportion. Line weight.

Year 7 English Revision List	
Topics to revise	Crafting Characters You will be asked to write a short narrative using an image as a stimulus for your writing. As part of the narrative piece of writing, you will want to consider: Characterisation and narrative perspective (1st/3'^d person) Using a variety of sentence starters (verb beginning, paired adjectives, emotion word, comma) Using ambitious vocabulary (e.g., precise nouns – oak instead of a <i>tree;</i> ambitious synonyms – petrified instead of scared) Using a variety of punctuation (e.g., semi-colons, dashes, speech marks, exclamation marks, etc.) Using figurative language Identity Poetry You will be asked to answer some comprehension questions on the poem 'The Hill we Climb' by Amanda Gorman. You will want to consider: TOOLS Title – What the title of the poem suggests about the poem Organisation – How is the poem organised e.g stanzas, rhyme scheme, rhythm. Language – What words and phrases has the poet used? Have they used any figurative language e.g. similes, metaphors, personification?

Revision Tips

Revision for Mathematics is based upon practice (and more practice). You need to be confident at the skills and concepts that make up the course in order to be able to work through the more challenging problems. Revision should be interactive, not just reading notes

A potential plan of action would be

Work through the plans below watching the relevant videos on Sparx maths (in the independent learning section)

Attempt the interactive questions on Sparx maths

Work through maths problems from sites like Third Space

Do not just read your notes/revision guides as you need to practice your Maths skills

Use your Knowledge Organiser to remember key terms and formulae, including the Tier 2 and 3 Vocabulary

Year 7 Religious Studies Revision List

Topics you should revise

- 1. What does it mean to be part of a community? (Why is it important to belong to a community? What unites and divides a community? What are my rights and responsibilities in my community? What can we learn from religious communities?)
- 2. What does it mean to belong to the Jewish community? (How does Judaism begin? Who is Moses? How do Jewish people worship? What is Shabbat? What are the Jewish food laws?)
- 3. What does it mean to be part of the Christian community? (How does Christianity begin? Who is Jesus? What is the Bible? What are the different Christian denominations? What are key festivals in Christianity?)
- 4. What does it mean to be part of the Muslim community? (How did Islam begin? What do Muslims believe about life after death? How do Muslims worship? What is sawm?)
