
The course is split in to two parts:

- Christian Practices
- Islam Beliefs
- Islam Practices

PAPER TWO: Thematic Studies

- Crime and Punishment
- Peace and Conflict
- Religion and Life
- Relationships and the Family





The Study of Religions

Beliefs and teachings: This section focuses on the specific beliefs and teachings of a religion. For example, beliefs about God and the roles of Jesus and Muhammad.

Practices: This section looks at the way the religious beliefs affect the lives of believers. For example, the Five Pillars of Islam, worship and pilgrimage.





Thematic Studies

Religion and Life: Animal rights, abortion, euthanasia, origins of life

Crime and Punishment: Causes of crime, aims of punishment, the death penalty, the treatment of criminals

Peace and Conflict: Causes of war, terrorism, nuclear weapons, pacifism

Relationships and Family: Marriage, divorce, sexuality, contraception

- Speak to us if you have any concerns


Revision Tips
