

Post Results: Information for Candidates

If you have any questions regarding your results, please see a member of staff from that department in the first instance.

If your subject teacher feels there is a possibility that a *review of marking is required they will see you to discuss this in further detail. It is our duty to inform candidates that when a review takes place there is a possibility of a result either staying the same, going up to a higher grade boundary or down to a lower grade boundary. Candidates must sign an agreement form before we request a review of marking. In some instances, there may be a charge for this service.

**A review of marking is to ensure that the agreed marking scheme has been applied correctly. Papers are not remarked.*

The subject department will notify candidates the outcome of the post results request.

The exam Awarding Body will make grade boundaries public on their websites on candidate results release dates.
