How you can support your child

- Ask to see their **homework** and make sure they complete it with care.
- Help them to meet **deadlines.**
- Help your child to be organised about having the right equipment every day.

- **Do not be fooled** by the "...but music really helps!" argument
- **Get involved** test them
- Vary the methods: summary notes/mind maps/ test cards / post-its/rewrite, reduce, repeat!
- Speak to your teachers take advantage of the support they give with revision e.g. revision sessions afterschool, one to one support
