Dear Parent/Carer & Prospective BHC Student 2020-2022,

Re: Barrow Hall College Places & Transition Work

I hope that this letter finds you and your family healthy and well during these challenging times.

I write in order to provide you with some information with regards to the security of BHC places for a September 2020 start and the provision of work for year 11 students in the coming weeks.

Firstly, may I take the opportunity to reassure you that college places already offered are secure and that no student will be put at a disadvantage despite the cancellation of GCSE examinations. Currently 96% of our courses are running based on student numbers. The handful of students affected by a course not running will be contacted shortly via telephone to discuss alternative options.

Secondly, I would like to inform you of our intention to provide students with 'transition' or 'bridging' work which will provide students with a foundation of knowledge and understanding in the subjects they are going to study from September at Barrow Hall College or an alternative post-16 provider. We want to ensure that all of our students, no matter their post-16 destination are supported and are given the head-start needed to make what can be a challenging transition somewhat easier. Our teaching staff are working hard to set up 'google classrooms' in order for students to access this transition work remotely. Students are able to join the classrooms now and details of how to do this are attached, however the resourcing of courses is a work in progress. We are aiming to launch the courses after the traditional Easter holidays and will let you know as soon as they go live.
