Think of Google Classroom (GC) as your/your child's digital link to learning.

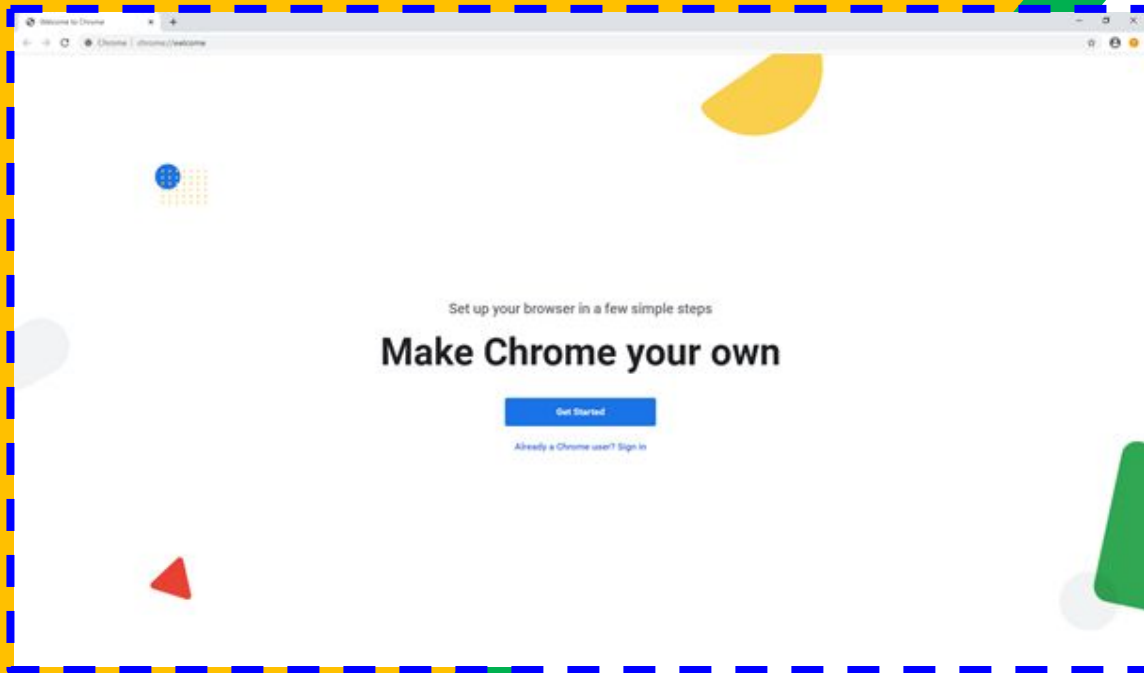
Teachers use GC to share classwork, assignments, homework (set and mark), post announcements and much more with students AND parents/carers!

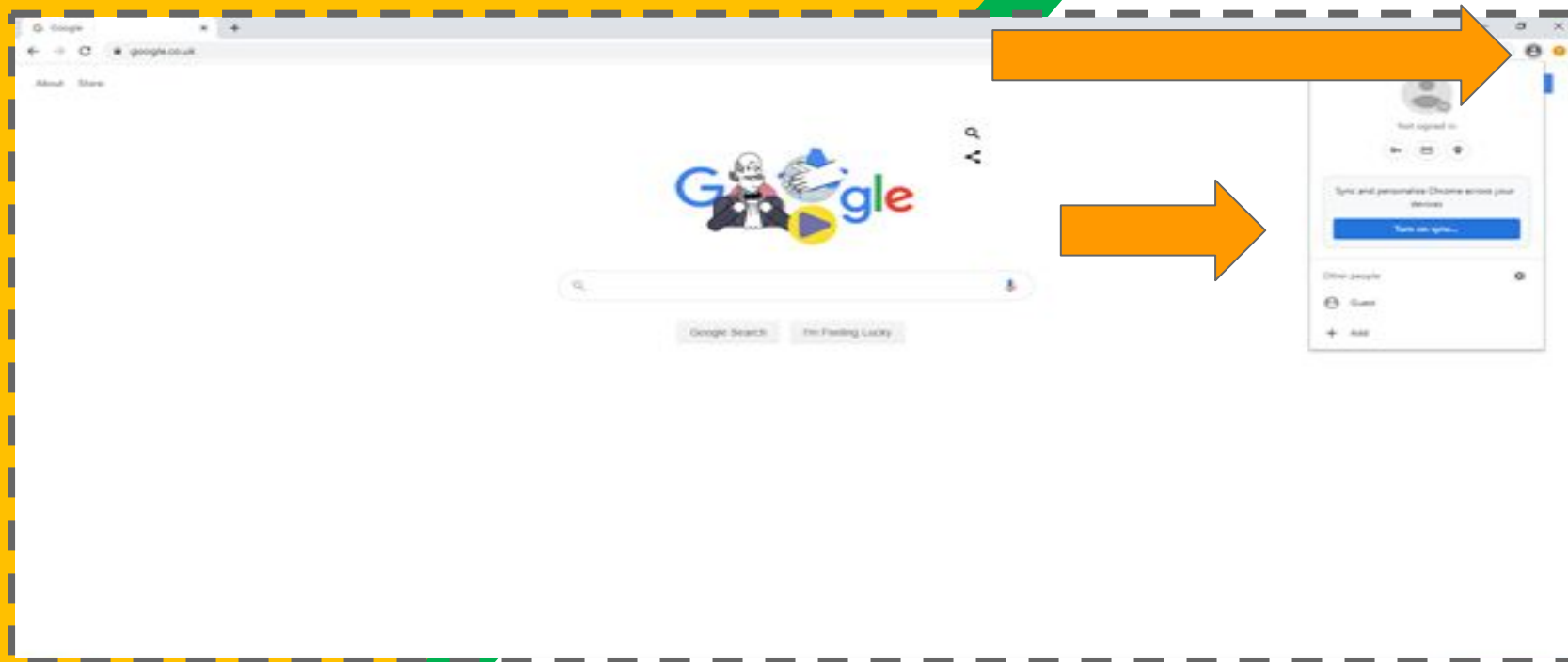


Open google chrome (never internet explorer or another browser)

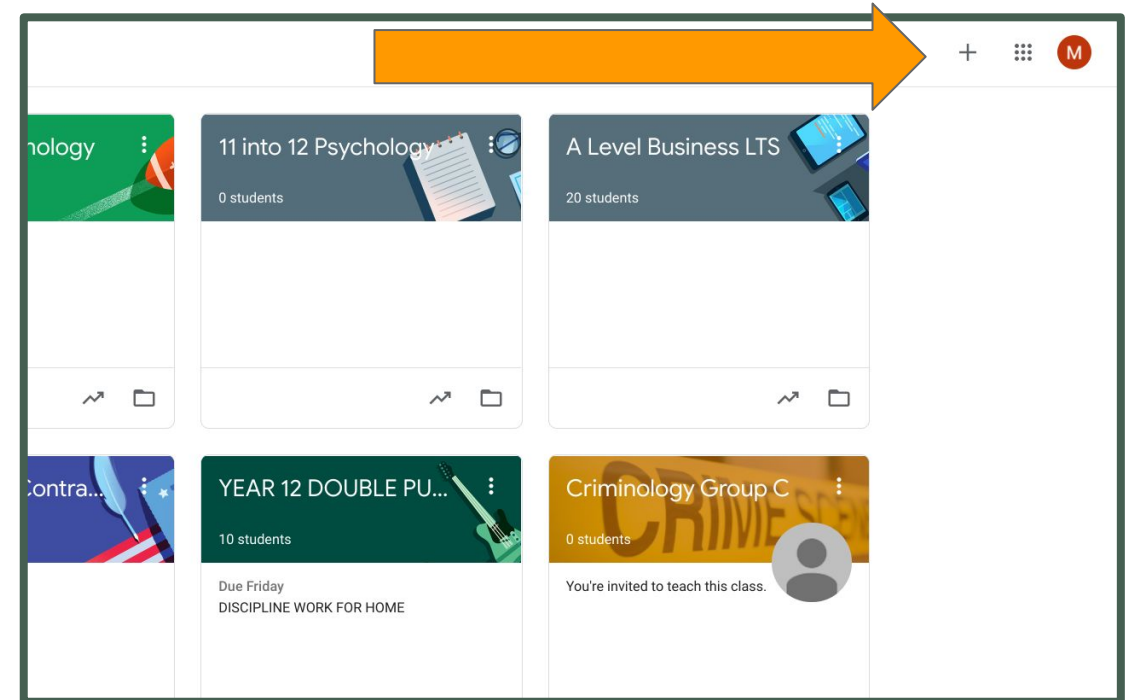
Click on the waffle button and then the Google Classroom icon.


Navigating Classroom

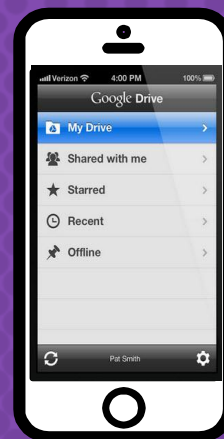
