Your child will bring Spellings home on a Friday and he/she needs to learn these for at least 10 minutes each night. There will be a spelling test the following Friday.

Reading

Reading will also form a key part of the Year 1 homework. A passion for reading is very important in Year 1, as we will be exploring lots of stories. Please encourage your child to keep reading for enjoyment and we suggest at least 10 minutes reading every day. Your child has a Reading Record which we would like signing by a responsible adult who hears your child read. We will be monitoring the reading records so please make sure their book and Reading Record is sent in to school every day- your child could win a prize for super reading!!!

Phonics Videos

Every fortnight we will send your child home with a letter full of QR codes which will take you to Read Write Inc phonics videos. You can access QR codes by hovering over them with a camera from a tablet or phone. With the upcoming phonics tests this year, we ask that you view one video a day.

<u>Y1 Autumn Curriculum</u>

Our new Topic for Autumn 1 is 'Ourselves'.

<u>English</u>

At Greenbank Primary School, we follow Read Write Inc. This includes daily phonics and English lessons. We have adopted the Colourful Semantics approach for English, to help children structure sentences for writing.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths this half term we will be learning place value within 10, addition and subtraction within 10, and shape. In class we will be doing lots of counting forwards and backwards, improving the speed of our addition and subtraction, and making sure our number formation is correct.

<u>Our Author</u>

Our Author this term is Jill Murphy who writes brilliant books such as 'Five Minutes Peace', 'Whatever Next' and 'On Our Way Home'. Now we are in Year 1 we are trying to develop our independence as learners. We need to remember to be ready for learning for every lesson and remember our own reading books and homework.
