<u>Y6 Autumn Curriculum</u>

Our new Geography Topic for Autumn is 'Our World'. We will be looking at different biomes around the world and the effects of climate change and pollution.

English

In Autumn term we will be focusing on different aspects of Writing such as figurative and emotive language. There will also be a particular focus on handwriting after the long summer lay off!

To add to all this we will be looking at comprehension techniques such as inference and fact retrieval. We will be reading a range of different texts and attempt to comprehend them.

Our author for this Term is JK Rowling and we will be focusing our writing and whole class reading sessions on the Harry Potter series.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths this half term we will be looking at numbers to 10 million with a focus on place value and the four operations. After half term we will then move onto fractions. It is vital that the children know all of the multiplication and division facts to support their learning.

<u>Science</u>

Our Science topic in Autumn 1 is 'Living things and their habitats' and Autumn 2 is 'Animals including humans'.
